SITE PLAN DEVELOPMENT STATUS



Master Site Plan



Phase 1: UHS Parcel

 Construction complete including Servicing, Utilities and Landscaping

Phase 2: York Region Parcel

 Region finishing building envelope construction in next few months with interior works ramping up

Phase 3: Minto Parcel

- Resubmission anticipated for May 2022; awaiting pre-consultation meeting
- Parklands also awaiting preconsultation meeting scheduled for end of April



CONSTRUCTION UPDATE





- Construction of twelfth structural framing floor is complete
- Elevator installation underway
- Drywall installation underway





- Installation of electrical, plumbing, and fan coil units underway
- Exterior cladding panels are installed up to the eleventh floor
- The grey pre-cast panels will be prepared to be stained to look like the city-approved exterior colour scheme
- Window installation complete up to eighth floor
- Roofing installation complete

Site Plan Highlights

- 38 Back-to-Back Townhomes (Orange) & 81 Traditional Townhomes (Blue) for 119 total units; reduced from 153 on 2017 site plan
- Pedestrian connectivity from Greentree through to Region campus or out to Aldona Road and Anna Russell Way to be maintained
- Additional lands being acquired in order to provide a municipal park as an expansion to the Anna Russell Parkette



Anna Russell Parkette



- Minto has coordinated with the landowners of 34, 36 and 38 Eureka Street to acquire the lands shown on the image in order to provide a municipal park to the City of Markham as part of Minto's development
- 34 Eureka St is included as the City required additional public frontage for the park. The rear yards of 36 and 38 provide additional lands to help in programming the park
- The lands remain subject to planning approvals (severance and rezoning) before they can be developed as a park
- Pre-consultation meeting with Markham scheduled for late April

STARTING DATE: FALL 2021

EXPECTED DURATION OF PHASE: APPROXIMATELY FOUR MONTHS (MARCH 2022)

The Regional Municipality of York is pleased to provide this update on construction activity for the new affordable housing building for seniors in your community.

Housing York Inc., York Region's non-profit housing provider, is committed to being a good neighbor throughout the construction process and beyond. We will work closely with our construction partner Martinway Contracting, and the City of Markham to ensure that a comprehensive construction management plan is followed.

The health and safety of construction workers and you - our neighbours - is our top priority.

As with any construction project, you may experience some inconveniences around the site. Martinway will make every effort to minimize disruptions when possible. We appreciate your support and understanding as we bring modern affordable housing for seniors into the community.

What to expect during this phase of construction:

- · Construction of 12th floor as well as the roof and 9th floor mechanical penthouse
- Installation of electrical, plumbing and heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC)
- Window framing is underway with window installation expected to take place in January and February
- Exterior cladding (covering) installation has been completed up to the 4th floor and will continue for the remaining floors
- · Once enclosed, work will continue primarily on the interior of the building throughout the winter
- · Brief, intermittent traffic disruptions as materials and machinery are transported to and from the site
- Periods of increased noise, vibration and traffic or truck activity
- Regular road sweeping that is enhanced as needed





Martinway and York Region are taking measures to reduce impacts during this phase as much as possible. Safety is a priority. Please slow down when travelling through a construction area.
