LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

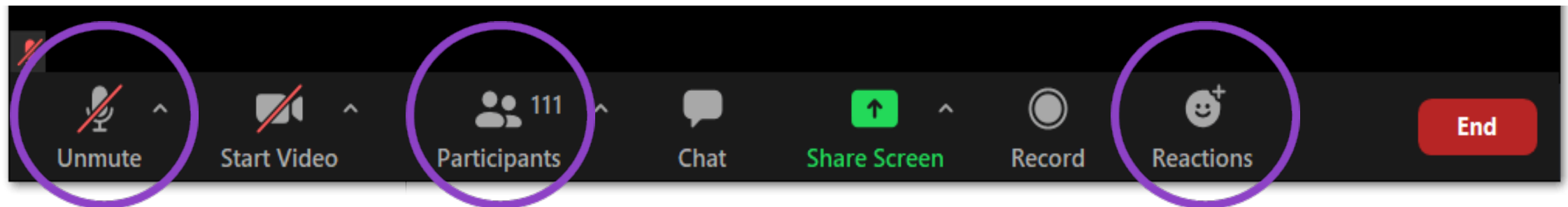

RAPID HOUSING INITIATIVE

- CMHC launched the Rapid Housing Initiative (RHI) to support rapid creation of new affordable housing
- York Region submitted previous RHI applications in 2020 and 2021 but was not awarded funding
- York Region proceeded with planning applications to get the Box Grove site development ready should additional funding be secured
- CMHC recently announced RHI Round 3 – an opportunity for Box Grove
- RHI applications are due March 15, 2023. CMHC will approve projects by summer 2023.

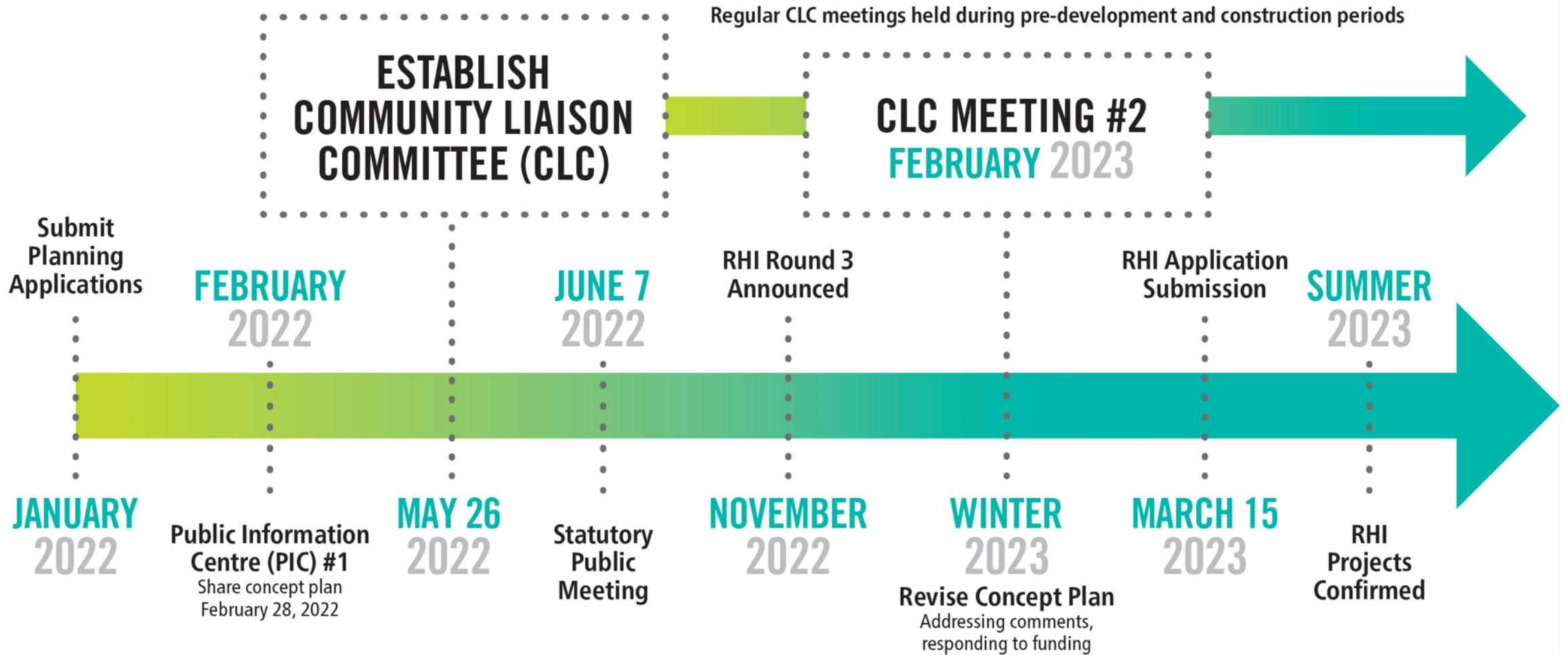


HOW DOES THIS IMPACT THE PROJECT?

- York Region plans on reapplying for RHI funding to support the Box Grove project
- York Region is in the early stages of identifying potential designers and builders if funding is secured
- If RHI funding isn't secured, different concept plans are being explored such as a single-phase concept
- The same planning permissions are being requested, regardless of which development scenario is undertaken

WHAT WE HEARD

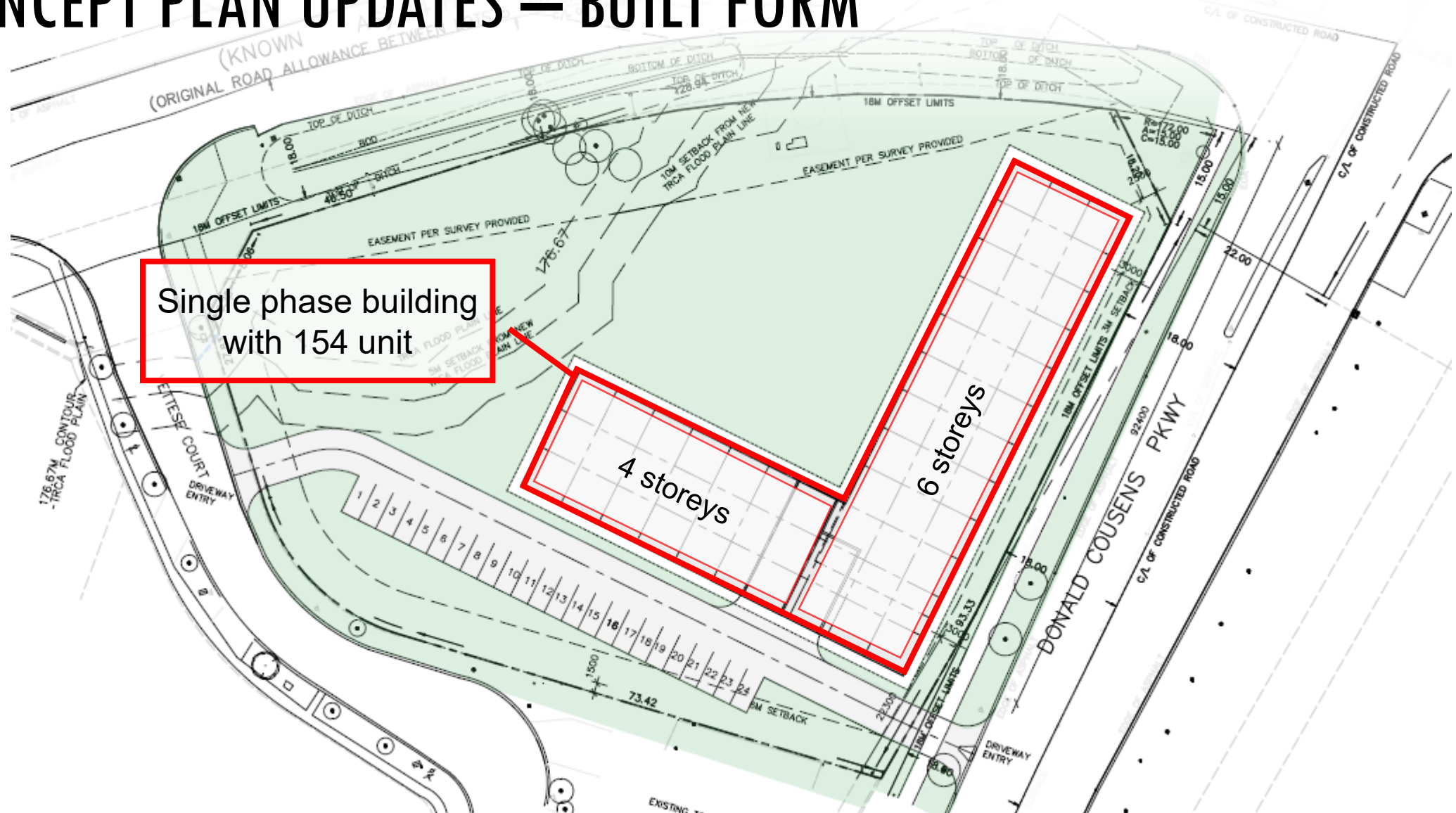
Questions and concerns:

- Lack of connectivity to nearby services for new residents

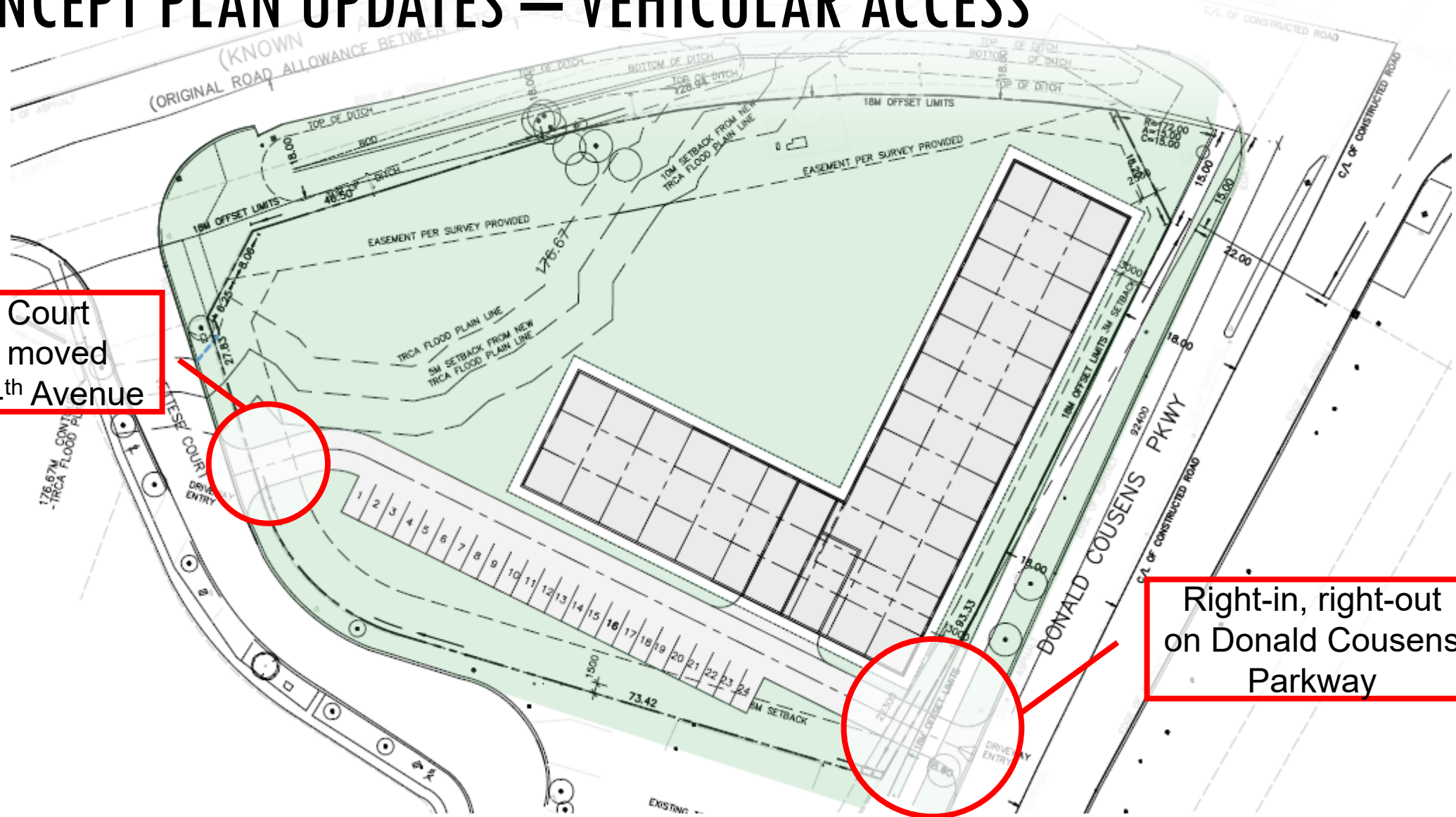

CONCEPT PLAN UPDATES – BUILT FORM



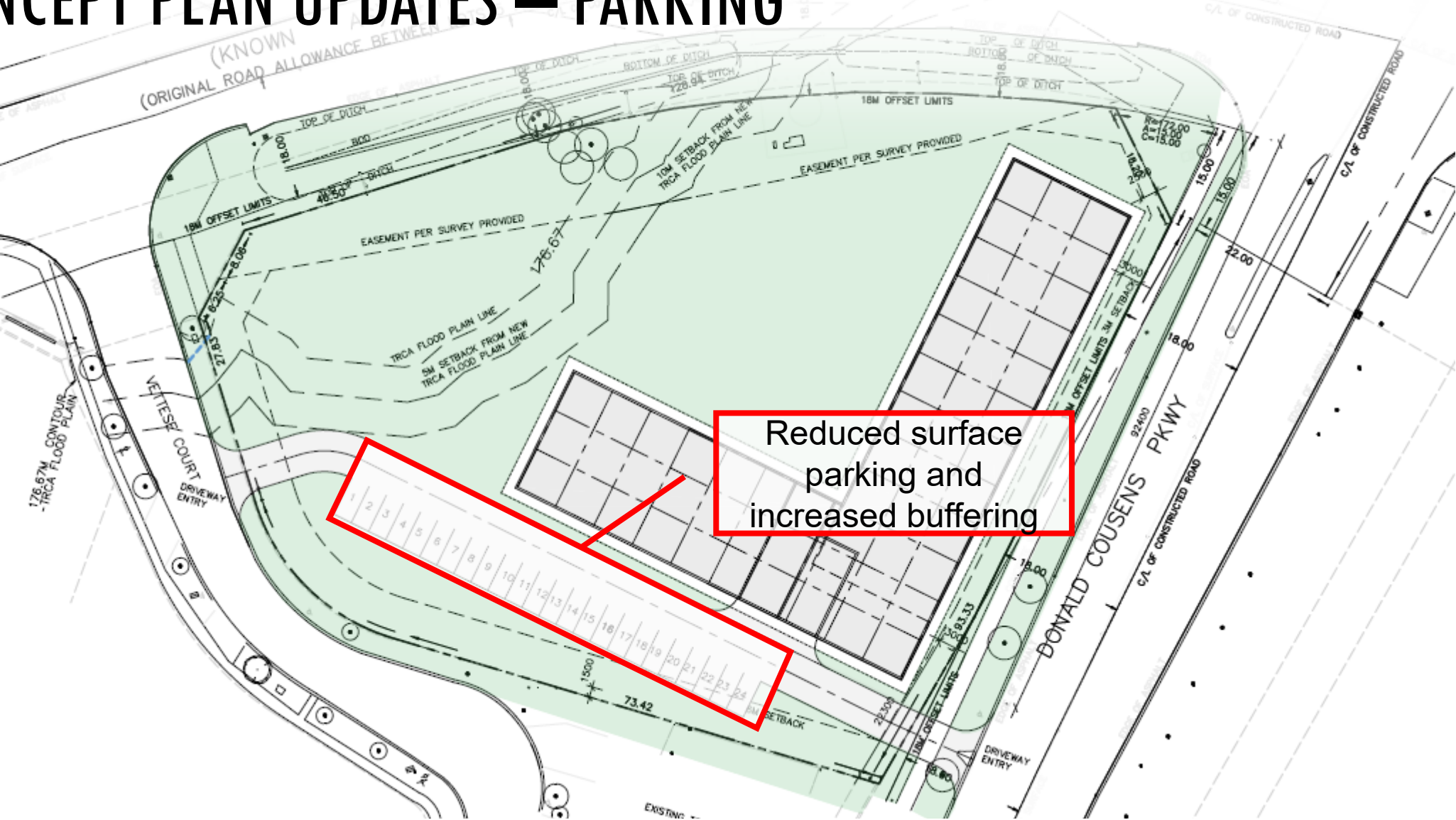
CONCEPT PLAN UPDATES – VEHICULAR ACCESS

Right-in, right-out on Donald Cousens Parkway

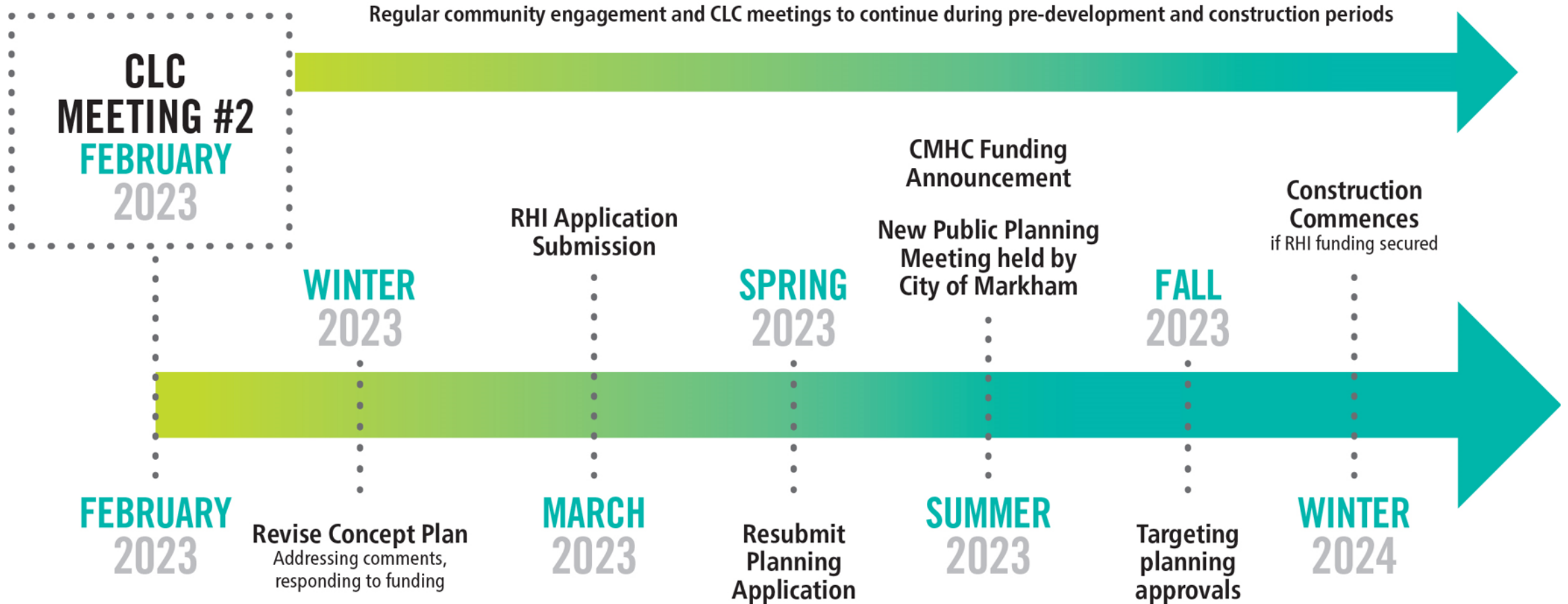
CONCEPT PLAN UPDATES – PARKING
