Availability of free Tuberculosis Medications Update to York Region health care professionals as of June 7, 2024

The York Region Public Health (YRPH) Tuberculosis (TB) Control Program continues to remind health care professionals that patients can obtain **free** TB medication for individuals who have:

- TB infection
- Active disease caused by the mycobacterium TB organism

YRPH TB Control Program does **not** provide free TB medications for infections caused by atypical mycobacteria.

Four designated pharmacies dispensing free TB medications

YRPH has a partnership with four designated pharmacies that dispense free TB medications.
