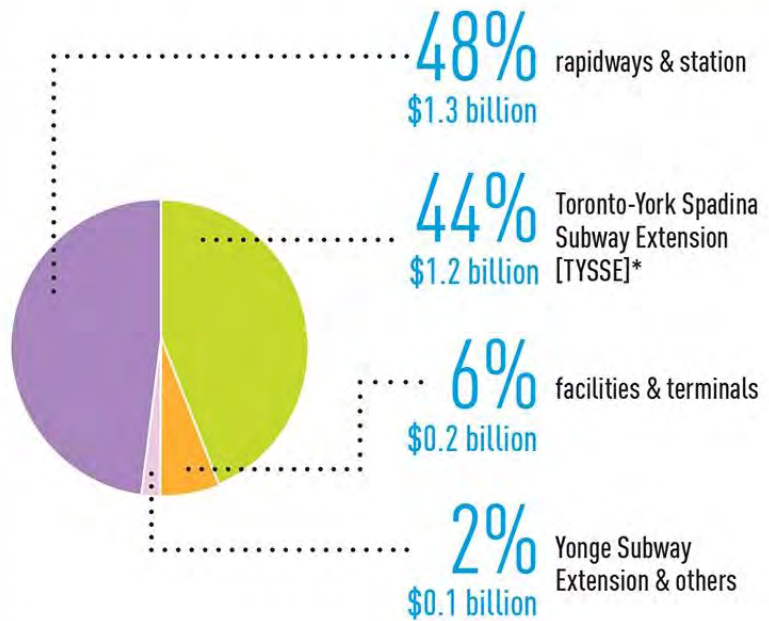


capital expenditures summary at end of 2017
