Please be advised that the following resolution was passed by Council at its October 6, 2015 meeting, please forward to the Region's Planning Dept.:

REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF YORK SERVICING TO EXISTING AND FUTURE EMPLOYMENT AREAS

MOVED by Councillor Kroon

SECONDED by Councillor Ferdinands

WHEREAS Strategic Employment Lands located on the east-side of Highway 404 within the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville are essential to ensuring the long term financial sustainability of the Town;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville and the Regional Municipality of York have submitted comments to the Province of Ontario through the Provincial Plans Review process in relation to strategic employment lands along the Highway 404 corridor and the ability to extend servicing to said lands;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Richmond Hill Council at its meeting on September 29th, 2015 has resolved that the Regional Municipality of York allocate additional servicing capacity for the West Gormley Secondary Plan Area, the North Leslie Secondary Plan Area and other sites requiring future Planning approvals;

AND WHEREAS the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville has similar servicing constraints that are impacting future development in the communities of Gormley (east of Highway 404) and Vandorf;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Regional Municipality of York be requested to aggressively plan, design and construct infrastructure that would be required to grant additional servicing capacity to the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville to service existing and future employment areas in the communities of Gormley and Vandorf;

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT should the Regional Municipality of York respond favourably to the request from the Town of Richmond Hill, the additional capacity granted to service West Gormley and North Leslie not be done to the detriment of any future servicing needs in the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.
