York Region

York Region has installed a new pedestrian crossing on Yonge Street at the Holland Landing Community Centre and Library in the Town of East Gwillimbury.

Called a pedestrian crossover in the *Highway Traffic Act*, the crossing has signs, pavement markings and flashing lights to define the crossing area, increase visibility and driver awareness.

Push the button to cross

Pedestrians push the button to activate the flashing lights and receive the right of way. For added safety, pedestrians are reminded to make eye contact with drivers and look both ways.

Stop for pedestrians

Drivers are legally required to stop for pedestrians at pedestrian crossovers. Drivers must also wait until pedestrians have fully crossed the pedestrian crossover (PXO) before proceeding.
